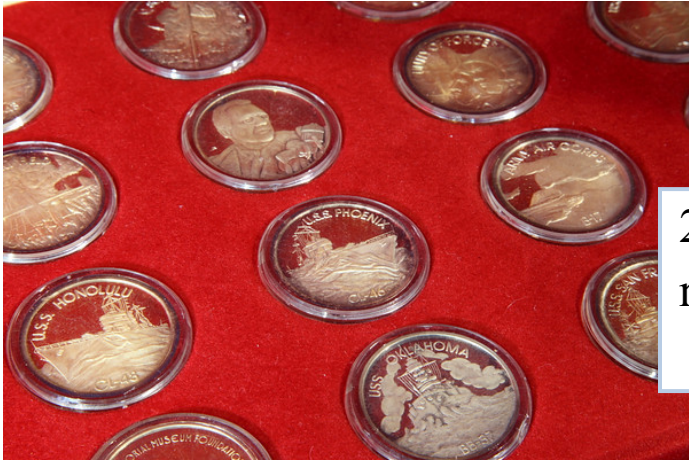

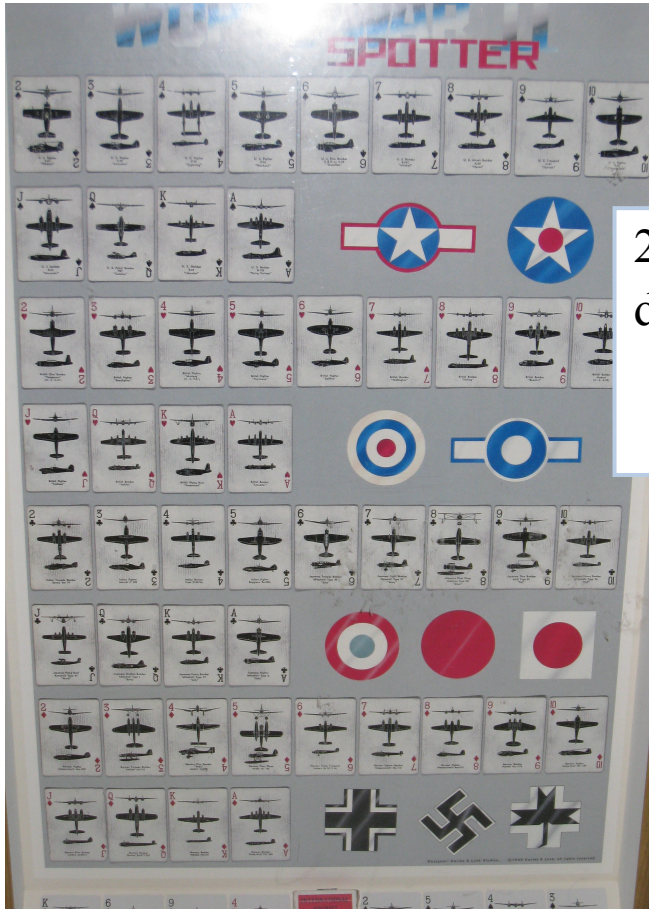

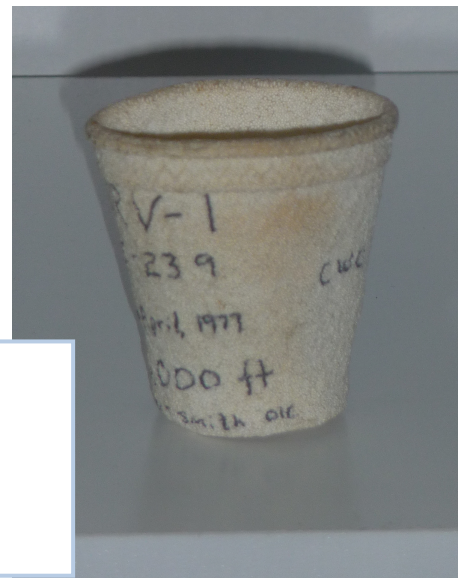


23. What was this contraption used for? How would today's technology replace this machine?
